Forward Funds Trust 2021 Capital Gain Distributions Paid

The Salient Funds identified in the table below had short-term and long-term capital gain distributions paid on December 10, 2021.

During each calendar year, mutual funds realize gains and losses from selling securities in their portfolios. Tax laws require mutual funds to distribute the net gains from these sales to shareholders by year-end.

A final determination of the tax character of distributions paid by the Funds will not be known until the completion of the fiscal year. The actual amounts and sources of the amounts for accounting and tax reporting purposes will depend upon the Fund's investment experience during the remainder of its fiscal year and may be subject to changes based on tax regulations. The final determination of the tax character of the distributions paid in 2021 will be reported to shareholders in early 2022 on Form 1099.
